Through smart technology and a new way of looking at production methods, we're now developing a whole range of vegetable snacks. Sustainably produced, from local or left-over ingredients. Guided by the zero-waste approach.

Crispy Dutch krupuk, suitable for vegans. Made from local rockweed and sweet onions harvested nearby. These products signalled the start of new snacks and new collaborations. Together with GRO, we create umami Krupi Chips. Made from succulent oyster mushrooms which grow on used coffee grounds. At the Wilthagen factory, we turn misfit bell peppers and onions into tasty vegetable crisps. And we're developing new varieties, like beetroot and sweetcorn. Colourful and bold in flavour.
